### How to access the CARICOM market

To qualify for duty-free movement within CARICOM, your products must meet a few simple regional rules. The key is to demonstrate that your product has been substantially transformed in Belize.

- PRODUCTS MUST BE MADE OR FINISHED IN BELIZE, WITH A CLEAR LEVEL OF PROCESSING OR VALUE ADDED.
- 2 SIMPLE ACTIONS LIKE RELABELING OR REPACKAGING ARE NOT ENOUGH. THE PRODUCT NEEDS TO UNDERGO REAL MANUFACTURING OR TRANSFORMATION.

By shifting your production or final processing to Belize, your products can easily qualify for free movement across the entire region, turning foreign demand into a local opportunity.


